Report on the audit of the Standalone Financial Results

#### **Opinion**

We have audited the accompanying standalone quarterly financial results of DJS Stock & Shares Limited (the company) for the quarter ended 31<sup>st</sup> March 2020 and the year to date results for the period from 1<sup>st</sup> April 2019 to 31<sup>st</sup> March 2020, attached herewith, being submitted by the company pursuant to the requirement of Regulation 33 of the SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015, as amended ("Listing Regulations").

In our opinion and to the best of our information and according to the explanations given to us these standalone financial results:

- i. are presented in accordance with the requirements of Regulation 33 of the Listing Regulations in this regard; and
- ii. give a true and fair view in conformity with the recognition and measurement principles laid down in the applicable accounting standards and other accounting principles generally accepted in India of the net profit and other comprehensive profit and other financial information for the quarter ended 31st March 2020 as well as the year to date results for the period from 1st April 2019 to 31st March 2020

### **Basis for Opinion**

We conducted our audit in accordance with the Standards on Auditing (SAs) specified under section 143(10) of the Companies Act, 2013 (the Act).
